Tuition for 3 & 4 YO classes is payable in nine monthly installments, August-April. TK tuition is paid in nine monthly installments, May—January.

Four Mile Preschool is a non-profit interdenominational early learning program that nurtures the spiritual, social, emotional, intellectual, creative and physical development of 3, 4 and 5 year old children. Our class sizes are limited. The staff consists of one certified teacher per class and teaching assistants, who are all qualified in First Aid, CPR, as well as TLC (Tender Loving Care). Each child is taught that he or she is special with their own unique talents and gifts. Each one is handled with respect

and love.

To enroll in classes, all children must be completely potty-trained. For the 3 year old classes, children must three before September 1. For the 4 year old classes, children must be four before September 1. TK students MUST have completed at 4 year old programs AND be five before September 1. A non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 is payable at the time of registration.

A \$50 non-refundable supply fee is due with first month's tuition.

For students enrolled in Four Mile Childcare Center paying full-time monthly or full-day rates, regular preschool tuition is included in childcare fees. Enrichment Class is parents responsibility.

Scholarship funding to reduce tuition costs is available to households earning less than \$105K +\$18514 for each child.
